

Bathroom Facilities

There are four bathrooms available to *Torsk* overnight participants. There is one on the Lightship *Chesapeake* where meals and lessons are provided and three aboard the submarine, but those aboard the submarine are not normal toilets.

To operate the submarine toilets (or heads) please follow these directions:

1. Use the toilet.
2. Pull the lever on the toilet to open the valve into the sewage tank.
3. Use a paper cup to pour water into the toilet to force the waste into the tank.
4. Close the valve.
5. Dispose of your paper cup in a trash can.

It is very important that you and your group members do not throw anything into the toilet that is not toilet paper because paper cups and paper towels will clog the valve and the toilet will be unusable until it is repaired after the overnight.

The *Torsk* crew members will provide water to rinse the toilet (and brush your teeth before Lights Out) and waterless hand sanitizer to clean your hands.

Also, please be reminded that this is a World War II submarine and therefore she has World War II type toilets. They are not as large as a house bathroom. They are only large enough to fit one person and a toilet.
